### Book bags and satchels/rucksacks

All pupils in Reception to Year 2 should be supplied with a school book bag. These can be purchased from the PFA or from Teenywear. These bookbags are optional from Year 3 and parents can choose to supply a SMALL satchel or rucksack suitable to hold up to A4 size papers, a small snack and water bottle. The school does not have the space to store large rucksacks.

### Jewellery, Hair Ornaments, Make-up and Nail Varnish

For health and safety reasons we do not allow children to wear jewellery. The exceptions to this rule are earring studs in pierced ears. Children are required to remove any items during PE lessons to prevent them from causing injury.

Watches are permitted from Year 3 but also should be taken off for PE. However, 'smart watches' are not allowed to be worn in school as they are classed as a device/mobile phone and will be treated as such i.e. taken from the child and returned at the end of the school day.

Hair bands/beads and head scarves should be simple in design in maroon, black or white (Pink in Summer Term only). Clips in silver, black or white.

Make up and nail varnish may not be worn to school.
